MCO—Mears transportation offers one-way shuttles at \$23 per person and requires no advanced reservation. Mears is located on the A-Side and B-Side of the Terminal on the Ground Transportation Level (level 1).

MCO – Taxi approx. \$45-55 one-way Uber/Lift approx. \$25-51 one-way. Located at Arrivals (Level 2)

SFB – Taxi approx. \$100-\$130 one-way. Uber/Lift approx. \$46-89 one-way. Located outside Terminal B door.
